AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in all jump heights and in all classes.

Purple Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs who have qualifying runs.

New Titles rosettes will also be awarded. Only Q. ribbons for Chances, no placement ribbons for this class.

NADAC TREATS RULE

NADAC allows handler to carry treats during a run if the treats are secured in a sealed container that is not visible to the dog, the judge or other exhibitors. If a container or a sealed bag falls out during a run it is not grounds for elimination unless the judge of record believes there is unethical behavior involved.

JUDGING

First dog on the line Friday at 4:00 p.m., Saturday at 8:30 a.m., Sunday at 7:30 a.m.

An explanation of Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler as follows:

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored & placed with their Standard Division jump height.

CLASS ENTRY – VETERAN DOGS

As of January 2014 – Dogs must enter the Veteran Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.

EQUIPMENT

All Equipment meets NADAC specifications and will include A-Frame, Dog Walk, both with rubber surface, tunnels, hoops, weave poles @ 24" gap & 42" height, winged & wingless jumps.

RUNNING ORDER

Friday & Sunday – Tall to Small Saturday- Small to Tall

MOTELS

All Exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the hotel/motel grounds so that these motels/hotels will continue to accept dogs. Check with motels/hotels regarding rates and dog policy when making reservations. We do not guarantee that dogs are accepted.

From the metropolitan Kansas City area:

Coming either from the North or the East on I-435. In Kansas take exit 1B - K-10 west towards Lawrence You will travel about 25 miles on K-10. The second stoplight you will encounter in Lawrence is Harper St. Turn right onto Harper street. The fairgrounds and arena are ½ mile on your right.

From the West:

Exit I-70 at either exit 197, 202 or 204.

Proceed South to 23rd street

Proceed East on 23rd street to Harper

Turn left/west on Harper

The fairgrounds and arena are ½ mile on your right

From the South:

Traveling North on 59 highway

Turn right/east on 23rd street

Proceed East on 23rd street to Harper

Turn left/west on Harper

Fairgrounds/arena ½ mile on right

For Specific Directions to Douglas County Fairgrounds:

Visit www.mapquest.com. Click on the Icon "Driving Directions." In the beginning address area enter the location you are staying at. In the destination address area enter the address for Douglas County Fairgrounds 2120 Harper St., Lawrence, KS 66046. You will receive specific directions that are printable.

SITE INFORMATION

The surface indoors is rolled dirt. It is a multi-function arena so horses and cattle may have used the facility previously. There are indoor bathrooms. There will be crating space available inside the arena. We ask, when possible, that crates be stacked. Standard 4' by 4' X-pens will be allowed, but only for use by 2 or more dogs. 4' by 4' X-pens to be used by only 1 dog will only be able to be set up outdoors; if you set up indoors with this intention and space becomes limited it will be requested that you move to outside the building.

As with every agility trial picking up after your dog(s) is a handler responsibility and must happen. This is a very nice site and we want to be able to hold many trials here. Please help us in keeping the site clean and as we found it before arriving with lots of dogs. We hope you come to this show and have a wonderful fun time with your dog(s). Thanks for your cooperation on these matters.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC, LLC agility trials. All dogs, including Novice are required to have a NADAC registration number in order to enter a trial. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial. The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Refunds will be made for bitches that come in season after the closing dates (Less Administrative Fee). Handler must present a Vet Certificate before the show starts. Refund of entry fees before the closing date will be charge an administrative fee of \$25.00/dog entered. Refund of entry fees after the closing date will be charge an administrative fee of \$35.00/dog.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. Dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish. No food, toys or devices of any kind are permitted on the course. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in being excused from the ring.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC, LLC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks. **Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these any harm arising from these.

U2 Kan Du Agility {including its officers, directors and members, and event organizing committee, Douglas County Fairgrounds, Lawrence, Kansas, {including its officers, Agents, and employees} and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses {including legal fees} by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my {our} participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties of any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
